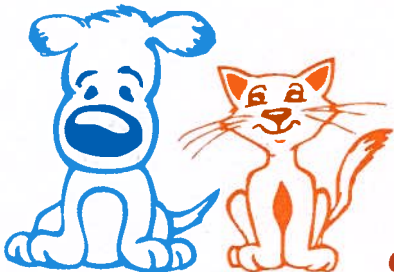



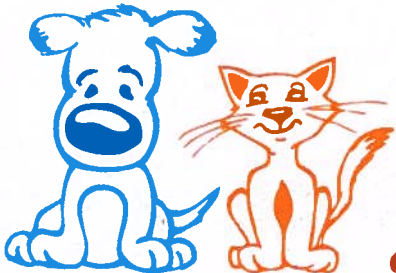

Dogs and cats are examined, vaccinated, dewormed, treated with flea preventive, microchipped, and spayed or neutered prior to adoption. See your veterinarian for recommendations about vaccination, deworming, and flea preventive schedules.

- FVRCP: Cat 3-in-one vaccine (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia).
- Rabies: 1-year Rabies vaccination.
- Deworm: Pyrantel, a medication which treats common intestinal parasites such as roundworms. ***This medication does not treat tapeworms.***
- Advantage II: Advantage is a monthly topical flea treatment.
- Paradefense: Paradefense is a monthly topical flea treatment (same ingredients as found in Advantage II).
- Combiva II: Combiva is a monthly topical flea treatment (similar to Advantage II)
- Microchip: a form of ID. It does not replace a license or ID tag. A microchip is about the size of a grain of rice and is implanted under the skin between the shoulder blades. The microchip is inactive until it is read with a scanner used by shelters and veterinary clinics. Each microchip produces a unique number when read with a scanner. In order for your pet to be reunited with you, you must register your pet's microchip. Registration can be done for any brand of microchip for free at www.foundanimals.org.

The Bay Area has seen an outbreak of canine influenza virus in dogs. Adopted dogs should be monitored for signs of coughing, sneezing, or decreased activity and call their veterinarian if signs are noted. This disease is contagious to other dogs and dogs can also be infected without showing symptoms. Adopters should keep their dogs separate from other dogs for 7 days after adoption to observe them for signs.

Please call Reference Laboratory Customer Support at 1-888-433-9987 if additional testing (PCR, CBC, etc.) is needed within this time frame. Note that due to stability, most hematology tests can only be added on up to 72 hours from time of collection.

NOTES

SEROLOGY

- a The American Academy of Feline Practitioners highly recommends confirming FIV ELISA positive results. Consider an alternate serologic method such as the FIV Antibody by Western Blot (test code 896) or a Feline Triple SNAP test (test code 3755 or performed in house). Maternal antibody may be present in uninfected kittens younger than 6 months of age. Cats vaccinated with the FIV vaccine may test positive on any serologic test as early as 28 days post-vaccination and stay positive for at least 1 year. In serologically positive cats that have been vaccinated or have an unknown vaccination history, an FIV RealPCR Test (test code 2866) should be considered to help identify FIV-infected cats.
